Central Purpose

- Regulation of private sector, for-hire passenger carriers within the Washington Metropolitan Area without regard to political boundaries.

Key Facts

- Established in 1960 pursuant to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, Pub. L. No. 86-794, § 1, 74 Stat. 1031 (1960), *as amended* by Pub. L. No. 87-767, 76 Stat. 764 (1962), Pub. L. No. 101-505, 104 Stat. 1300 (1990), & Pub. L. No. 111-160, 124 Stat. 1124 (2010), *codified at* D.C. CODE ANN. § 9-1103.01 (2014).
- Three commissioners: One appointed by District Mayor from District agency with oversight of matters relating to WMATC; one appointed by Maryland governor from MDPSC; one appointed by Virginia governor from VADMV.

- Proceedings initiated each year.
- Passenger carrier licenses issued each year.

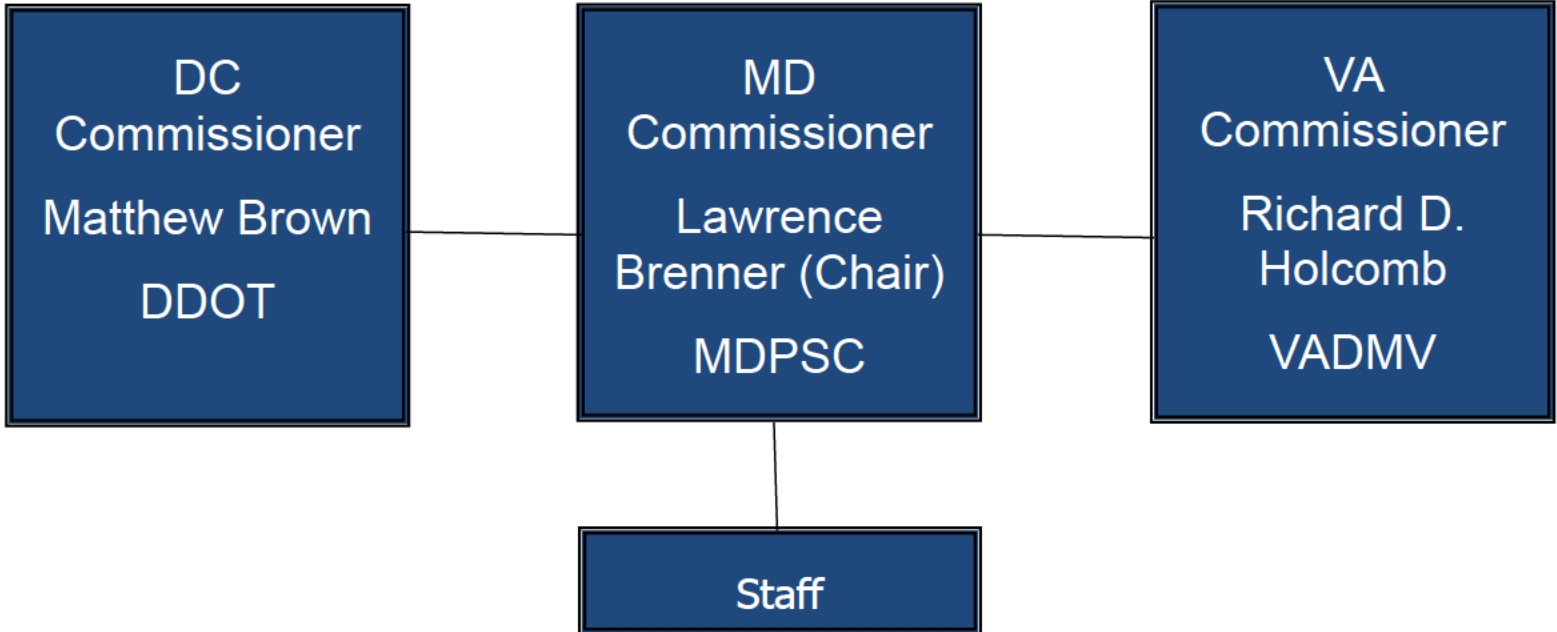
